NEW BUSINESS: Selection of Parish Council chair/co-chair, and secretary was made. Eileen Gretkierewicz volunteered to be chairperson. Pam Mertes volunteered to be co-chairperson, and Lisa DiMaggio volunteered to remain as secretary.

OPEN FORUM: Protecting God's Children will be held June 24th with dinner at 530 and the seminar from 6:00 to 9:00. We need to continue to push this seminar. Background checks are needed along with this seminar. It was agreed that all leaders in our parish, such as Eucharist Ministers that administer to the homebound, chairpersons from any event, and all that volunteer to work with children and the elderly go through Protecting God's Children seminar and have a background check. JoAnn Augustine made a motion for this, Sean Stawiacz and Jane Petitpren approved the motion. Michelle Meldrum to oversee this.

Amy O'Gara asked if we had a fire proof safe. Father David said we have a small one.

Stan Sommers asked if our money counters are bonded. Jane replied that they are not. A.O.D. does not require them to be bonded. We are insured through the Michigan Catholic Conference. Stan stated that if money counters were ever found to steal, they cannot be prosecuted. Jane will make a call to find out about this.

Stan Sommers asked if our parish files are confidential. It was reported that they are.

PASTOR'S REPORT:

- Fr. Nick Zukowski from St. Mary's in New Baltimore is the new Vicar for the Blue Water Vicariate.
- Father David asked that we evaluate how/when joint meetings are being held as far as meeting with Stewardship, S.A.C., and P.T.C.
- Father David suggested that Parish Council consider bringing in A.O.D. for a formation session to refresh what our purpose is, the aspects of decision making, the aspects of bringing people together, and our parish welcoming a new pastor.
- Parish Council guidelines are being updated and will be in the handbook.
- Father David thanked us for welcoming all of our seminarians that we hosted over the last nine years he has been Pastor. It has been a joy for him to be able to host them. It will be up to our new pastor whether or not we continue hosting.
- Father David made his last "Two Important Points"
 - 1. Continue stewardship formation. Get to the heart of questions and concerns that the parish has.
 - 2. There is an evangelization component to everything we do; how we live our faith, etc. The more we do, the stronger our parish/church will be.
