# **Continuing School Improvements**

- **Open House** -The open house held February 11<sup>th</sup> had a wonderful turnout. Several of the families showed interest in our pre-school program, as well as Kindergarten and First grade.
- **Academic Olympics** This year every member of our 5<sup>th</sup> -8<sup>th</sup> grade forensics and math teams received a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> place ribbon. There will be an opportunity to hear a sample of the forensics team readings at an assembly on Feb.23<sup>rd</sup>.
- Self- study Standard X Strategic Planning Mrs. Steele presented to the committee the need for a strong strategic plan. Marketing and enrollment strategies are in place but we need to look at fundraising policies and budgeting practices for the future. The committee also discussed the need for updating our wish list. Electrical upgrading is one area all present agreed needed attention. Some suggestions included more outlets in classrooms, lighting for the entrance to the parish parking lot, and better lighting outside the school gym.
- Standard XI-Child Care/Latchkey Plans are in place for latchkey to be available at IC for the fall 2007 school year. The school currently does have a license in place for child-care. More information will come available as the details are worked out.

#### **New Business**

- **PTC Report** The PTC has purchased eight new computers for the teachers' desks. Thank you PTC! The teachers are all looking forward to their updated technology.
- Other News New creative writing books have been purchased for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grades. New Kindergarten creative writing books were donated with the above purchase.
