Meeting opened with a prayer at 7:20 PM

Minutes of the June 3, 2014 meeting were approved with no corrections.

PASTOR'S REPORT:

- School began this morning; we have 162 students (compared to 152 last year), along with a new principal and a new sense of excitement.
- Over the last month improvements were made to the school building, including painting of the hallways, offices, and some classrooms; installation of new carpeting in various rooms; concrete work outside the upper elementary entrance. This entrance has long been a problem, and the doorway itself will be replaced sometime this month. (This project is being paid for from our *Changing Lives Together* proceeds, as upgrading the school entrances was one of the campaign goals.)
- Fr. Joe's summer adult education course was on "The Protestant and Catholic Reformations," and about 35 people participated each week.
- Early in August we held the funeral for Archbishop Vigneron's mother; The Mass was followed by a luncheon, and everything went smoothly.
- The parish office is back to regular office hours, closing at 4pm on Tuesday through Thursday, and at 3pm on Friday.
- Next Tuesday we will be hosting the vicariate clergy meeting
- On the weekend of September 13-14 there will be a special announcement at all the Masses promoting E-Giving, with an opportunity for parishioners to sign-up in the parish hall afterwards.
- Catechetical Sunday will be observed on September 21; at the 10am Mass that day, our Faith Formation catechists will be officially installed for this coming year.
- ChristLife resumes on Thursday September 25; this segment is called "Sharing Christ."
- Catholic author and alleged visionary John Leary will again be speaking here at I.C. on Sunday September
 There will be a Rosary after the 12 noon Mass followed by his talk; confessions will be heard, and his books and tapes will be available for purchase.

- The annual *Week of Prayer and Fasting to End Abortion and Convert All Nations* is scheduled for September 20-28. We will have a special Mass for this purpose on Monday September 29 at 7pm; Deacon Ken will also have special times of Eucharistic Adoration during the week (with times to be listed in the bulletin).
- I have been working on a new book the last few weeks, and sent it off to the publisher today. The title is On the Brink: American and the Coming Divine Judgment, and is should be out sometime in October.

Additional Comments:

It was noted that we received a grant from the Archdiocese of Detroit to provide new carpet in some of the classrooms.

- Greeting Card Ministry sent 7 cards in May, 10 in June, 7 in July, and 6 in August.
- Someone is needed to take over care of the Mary Garden.
- Funeral Lunch Ministry served five funeral lunches.
- Rosary Makers will meet after the 10am Mass this Sunday.
- Handcrafters will be meeting the 1st and 3rd Wednesday at noon beginning September 3rd.
- Coffee and donuts will be this Sunday September 7th after all Masses.
